## DEPENDENT(S) F-2 INFORMATION

**Instructions:** To request an I-20 for your spouse and/or children to join you in the U.S., you have to verify that you have sufficient funds to cover your family's expenses. When OIE has all the required documentation, we will process your request, which will be ready **in five (5) working days**. You will receive a new I-20 for yourself, updating your financial information, and a new I-20 for your spouse and/or children.

**OIE Policy:** OIE supports Georgia Tech student requests to have families join them in the United States. As Designated School Officials, we will provide you the I-20 when evidence of financial support is presented. While OIE issues I-20's to facilitate the F-2 visa application at a U.S. Embassy/Consulate, the decision to issue or deny visas is made solely by the consular officer. Please note that if your spouse is applying for an F-2 visa, they will have to bring financial documentation to the US Embassy/Consulate. Original bank statements and/or official letter from your department stating the amount of your assistantship will need to be provided.

**Procedures:**

1. Meet with an international student advisor to determine the financial support for the dependent I-20.
2. Complete the bottom of this form with your spouse and/or dependent's information
3. If you are a graduate student receiving an assistantship, have your graduate coordinator complete the financial support information on the other side and issue a financial support letter.
4. Turn in completed form to OIE
