Official Rules for Photo Submission:

What kind of photos can I enter?

Two categories of photos are accepted:

- Photographs of their overseas experiences taken by GT Study Abroad Students (degree-seeking) during Fall 2008, Spring 2009, or Summer 2009
- Photographs related to their experiences in the U.S. taken by GT International Students (degree-seeking) during Fall 2008, Spring 2009, or Summer 2009
- Suggestions for types of photos include GT students/faculty/staff, scenery, and culture.

What format should I use for my entry and how many photos may I submit?

- You are allowed to submit up to three photographs; separate entry forms must be filled out for each photo.
- A hard copy of the entry form must be completed and turned in to OIE.
- After you turn in your entry form, you will then receive instructions by email about how to submit your photo and a description of it online via T-Square. This description may be considered by the judges when choosing winning photos.

When and where do I submit my entry?

- DEADLINE for submitting entry form and photos is Friday, October 2, 2009 by 4:30pm.
- Please submit entry forms to the GT Office of International Education (OIE), 631 Cherry St., Savant Building, Suite 211, Atlanta, GA 30332-0284.
- After you turn in your entry form and are invited to join the GT OIE Photo Contest 2009 site on T-Square, upload your photo and description. More instructions will be provided at the time.

How are the winners chosen?

- Staff from OIE will decide on finalists in each of the two categories (international and U.S.) in mid-October.
- Winners will be chosen from among the finalists by the GT campus community through voting on T-Square during the week of October 19-23.

When will the winners be announced?

- The winners will be announced as part of International Education Week, November 16-20, 2009.
- On Tuesday, November 17, OIE will host an afternoon reception in the Student Center and display the contest entries, finalists, and winners.

Prizes! What could I win?

- Prizes include travel vouchers from STA Travel and passes for free admission to Fernbank Museum of Natural History. All photos may be used by OIE and GT in marketing materials.

Who needs to sign the consent statement on the Official Entry Form?

- Any persons who have posed in your picture, or are students, friends, family, etc. must sign in the additional signature spaces provided in the entry form. People in the background of photos, such as people walking down the street, market scenes, etc. do not need to sign.
