What can be entered in the Creativity Contest?

- Entries should be related to your study abroad experience during Fall 2008, Spring 2009, and/or Summer 2009
- Possible themes include, but are not limited to:
 - Recounting different parts of your study abroad experience – academics, friendship, travel
 - Sharing things you have learned – about your host culture, about the U.S., about yourself
 - Reflecting on how studying abroad has and continues to affect your life and plans
- Photographs cannot be entered in the Creativity Contest (enter them in the Photo Contest instead).
- Almost any other medium can be used. Examples include, but are not limited to:
 - Creative Fiction
 - Poetry
 - Journals
 - Letters
 - Drawings
 - Videos
 - Comics
 - Paintings
 - Sculptures
 - Music
 - Textiles
 - Graphic Design
 - Games

How do I enter the Creativity Contest?

- Turn in a hard copy of the official entry form and your contest entry to OIE (211 Savant)
- Entries are due by 4:30 pm on Friday, October 2

How will the winners be chosen? When will the winners be announced? What are the prizes?

- Contest winners will be chosen by staff in the Office of International Education.
- Criteria include originality, creativity, and overall quality and impact.
- Winners will be announced during International Education Week (November 16-20). All entries will be displayed at a reception the afternoon of Tuesday, November 17.
